Kuala Lumpur convention centre wins highest and most prestigious national award in human resources development

Riot's absence at HRDF event raises few eyebrows

KUCHING : Questions were raised after Human Resources Minister Datuk Seri Richard Riot Jaem 'disappeared' from an official function here yesterday, despite being seen earlier talking to ministry officials and other guests. He was originally scheduled to attend and give a speech at the launch of the Industrial Revolution 4.0 (IR4) Initiatives in Sarawak by the Human Resources Development Fund (HRDF).

Assistant Minister of E-Commerce Datuk Mohd Naroden Majais officiated at the ceremony on behalf of Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Amar Awang Tengah Ali Hasan, who was supposed to represent Chief Minister Datuk Patinggi Abang Johari Tun Openg at the event. Nonetheless, Riot prepared a montage speech which was aired at the start of the function, where he stressed on the importance of Sarawakians being aware of and prepared for the challenges of this new era of IR4.

He said there are 16,000 small and medium enterprises (SMEs) in Sarawak and each of them plays the vital role of becoming gamechangers in the business field. "The IR4 businesses, in general, will move towards digitalisation and this will change some of the ways we do business. There are strategies and initiatives in place to smoothen the impact of IR4 in Malaysia. "In this instance, I anticipate that there will be more to come in Sarawak, especially with regard to the digital infrastructure, to ensure that fair transformation could be made throughout Malaysia," he said.

Riot also said he generally supported the statement made by Abang Johari that Sarawak needs to be involved for digital technology to be able to create healthy competition with neighbouring countries such as Thailand, Indonesia and Vietnam. "With the launch today, it is my sincere hope that this would be a paradigm shift to help bring businesses in Sarawak to greater visibility on the international platform," he said.

'Hanya duit ini peninggalan arwah'

KLUANG - "Kami tak sangka akan terima bayaran dari Perkeso dan duit inilah satu-satunya peninggalan arwah untuk kami sekeluarga," kata Hambali Ahmad, 47. Dia merupakan bapa kepada mangsa kemalangan, Muhammad Amirul Hambali, 19, yang meninggal dunia 23 November lalu, menerima bayaran Faedah Pengurusan Mayat (FPM) daripada Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (Perkeso) cawangan Kluang, semalam. Kata Hambali, dia dan isterinya Rafidah Bariman, 40, tidak menduga mendapat bayaran itu, kerana arwah anaknya itu baru bekerja di kilang Schaefer System International Sdn Bhd kira-kira lima bulan lalu.

Menurutnya, bayaran Perkeso itu menjadi satu-satunya tinggalan daripada Muhammad Amirul untuknya sekeluarga dan pastinya akan digunakan sebaiknya untuk keperluan keluarga. "Terima kasih atas tindakan segera Perkeso Kluang yang uruskan dan buat pembayaran pampasan caruman ini. "Kami kini reda dengan dugaan yang menimpa sehingga mengorbankan anak sulung kami. Mulanya kami anggap hanya kemalangan biasa. Tapi tak sangka sampai meragut nyawanya.

Sebelum kejadian, hati saya dan isteri rasa tak tenteram seolah-olah akan berlaku sesuatu yang tak diingini. Rupanya benar, apa dirasai bawa kepada berita sedih iaitu kehilangan anak. Kami macam tak percaya tapi kini makin kuat dan reda untuk meneruskan kehidupan harian,” katanya kepada Sinar Harian. Sementara itu, Pengurus Pejabat Perkeso cawangan Kluang, Ahmad Suzaim Abdul Aziz berkata, Allahyarham merupakan anak sulung daripada tiga beradik yang bekerja di kilang di Simpang Renggam sejak 23 Mei lalu.

Menurutnya, walaupun Allahyarham baru sahaja bekerja namun majikannya terus bertindak mencarumnya dengan Perkeso. “Kemalangan yang berlaku kepada arwah adalah dikira sebagai bencana kerja mengikut Seksyen 24 (1) (A) Akta Keselamatan Sosial Pekerja 1969, iaitu kemalangan dalam perjalanan balik kerja. Ia melayakkan waris menerima pencen Faedah Orang Tanggungan (FOT). “Oleh kerana arwah masih bujang maka ibu dan bapanya akan menerima Pencen FOT yang akan dibayar pada setiap bulan sepanjang hayat mereka. Manakala adik arwah yang berusia 13 dan 17 tahun juga akan terima syer pencen ini sehingga mencapai usia 21 tahun.

“Pada hari ini (semalam), Perkeso menyerahkan bayaran FPM sebanyak RM2,000 kepada keluarga arwah yang mana ibu dan ayahnya akan menerima RM1,000 setiap seorang,” katanya ketika ditemui di kediaman keluarga Muhamad Amirul di Kampung Tengah Renggam, di sini, semalam. Dalam perkembangan lain, Ahmad Suzaim berkata, pihaknya ketika ini sedang mengumpul maklumat gaji daripada majikan bagi membayar pencen bulanan kepada waris. Turut sama menyampaikan bayaran tersebut ialah Penghulu Mukim Renggam, Asmi Mislan. Pada 23 November lalu, Sinar Harian melaporkan seorang remaja maut apabila motosikal yang ditungganginya merempuh sebuah lori di Kilometer (KM) 20.7 Jalan Simpang Renggam-Renggam.
